Breaches might lead to personal liability not only of the persons involved but also of the respective legal entity, its directors, and officers and potentially even the whole Uniper Group.

With our Compliance Management System, Uniper has taken far-reaching measures to detect, stop and mitigate compliance risks more effectively. Our program supports management in leading with integrity since being a role model starts from the top. Our employees at all levels have the responsibility to ensure Compliance.
